Puppy Contract

This contract is to all agreements and responsibilities of the Breeder and the Purchase. This contract is made only valid with the original purchaser. If the animal is resold, this contract will be void. In this contract the breeder is referring to Donald Ray, the owner refers to the original purchaser of the puppy whose name(s) appears on this contract and registration form. Please note in order to receive a Bull Yard pups this contract must be signed and returned to Bull Yard kennels.

1. Lifetime Temperament Guarantee- If at any time the purchased dog is found not to be compatible with the guarantee given to the original owner(s), return him/her and the ACA papers to our kennel, he/she will be replaced at no charge. The animal(s) purchase must be in good condition.
2. Lifetime Guarantee Against Dysphasia- If at any time if a Bull Yard Kennels Alapaha is found to be crippled the owner may return him/her to our kennel, along with the ACA papers and we will replace the dog at no charge.
3. Lifetime Parvo Virus Guarantee- If your Bull Yard Kennel Alapaha, dies from Parvo, return the ACA papers along with the laboratory verification and we will replace him/her at no charge.
4. The puppy will be immunized by the breeder for common canine diseases as appropriate for the age of the animal. Vaccination records will be provided. The purchaser is responsible for all subsequent vaccinations. Failure to properly vaccinate the animal will render this contract void. Proof of vaccination may be required by the breeder.
5. The purchaser is responsible for routine and necessary Veterinary care from the date of delivery of the animal. If the health of the animal is comprised due to physical neglect of the lack of veterinary care this contract is void.
6. If the animal exhibits a life threatening or sever life altering condition which is a result of congenital defect within the first 2 years of life, the breeder will ask for the following.
 - A. Veterinary records documenting the condition of the animal must be provided at the Purchaser's expense.

- B. At the breeder's desertion, the breeder may require examination by Veterinarian of the breeder's choice. Transportation of the animal to the breeder and any expenses incurred therein will be the responsibility of the purchaser. Additional expenses will be picked up by the breeder.
- C. If the animal is deceased, the requires that a complete autopsy be performed to ascertain the cause of death and of death and documentation be forwarded to the breeder's Veterinarian. Before euthanasia is administered, the breeder must be consulted or this contract is void. If the above terms were met, a replacement or refund will be as follows:

Replacement Terms:

- A. Within in a period of time agreed upon by the breeder and purchaser but not less than 6 months from the initial notification of the problem. A replacement puppy will be provided by the breeder if a suitable puppy becomes available. In order to receive a replacement pup you must return him/her to our kennel, along with the ACA papers and we will replace the dog at no charge. If you choose not to send the pup back, return the ACA papers and the pup still can be replaced at a charge of \$800.
- B. If for any reason the customer does not pick or accept there pup they are also that is also considered a replacement pup and will be replaced under the terms of Replacement terms A.

If a puppy is not available during the agreed upon time, the breeder will refund the purchaser the price as Follows,

- C. If the defect has caused the death of or required euthanasia of the animal, the Purchaser price will be refunded.

RESTRICTIONS:

1. In the event the purchaser is unable to care for the animal, the breeder must be notified and given first opportunity to purchase the animal at or below the initial purchase price.
2. If the Purchaser is found guilty of violation of the Animal Welfare or any Animal Abuse Laws, ownership of the animal will revert back to the breeder With Out refund of money.
3. If the Purchaser uses the animal for the purpose of dog fighting, ownership of the animal will revert to the breeder with out refund of money.
4. The purchaser agrees to retain the original registered name of the animal.
5. If the animal is used for breeding, the purchaser agrees to have the animal's hips and elbows examined radio graphically for evidence of hip and elbow dysphasia prior to breeding. The purchaser will provide a copy of the x-rays to the breeder.
6. The purchaser is solely responsible for the behavior of the animal after purchase. The breeder retains no liability for the animal's action.
7. All puppy purchases must be fully paid for by the time the pup turns six weeks old or all funds will be forfeited. All funds received in order to place a hold on a pup is considered a deposit and all deposits are non-refundable, but are transferable with notice. When purchasing more then one pup, there must be a deposit placed on each puppy.
8. Limitations of Guarantee – This guarantee applies to the original puppy owner only and is non – transferable. The puppy must be in good physical condition. No replacement or refund will be given if the male or female has been breed, neutered, spayed or registration application form has expired. Owner is responsible for transportation cost and from the kennel.
